Jennifer, our first MTM homeowner, who purchased her home in 2009, completed her 10-year program obligations in June, 2019. Jennifer purchased her home for \$135,000 in 2009 and its estimated 2018 value was \$206,000 – more than a 52 per cent increase. The ability for these families to move forward free from poverty under the MTM program is proven.
